

HUNTER REGION WOODTURNING DEMONSTRATION JOEY RICHARDSON (England) Saturday 13th October 2018 in East Maitland



Back by Popular Demand. Joey Richardson is an internationally acclaimed turner and sculptor, renowned for her delicate and richly hued wood forms. Her unique sculptures are inspired by nature, life experiences and imagination. Joey's work is instantly recognisable - combining her unique talents in the use of piercing, air brushing, colour, texture and artwork.



A Scholarship from The Queen Elizabeth Scholarship Trust (QEST) and Carpenters Company funded development studies in America where Joey was able to develop her amazing talent by working with people such as the late Binh Pho. In 2012 Joey was made a Liveryman of the Worshipful Company of Turners Company and in 2015 she was awarded the prestigious QEST Award of Excellence.



Joey's sculptures are held in many collections around the world. She regularly teaches and demonstrates her techniques globally and her enthusiasm for passing on knowledge is infectious. Joey is one of the leaders of the artistic wood

movement which is developing in the UK. She is currently planning, with QEST, a large international wood art exhibition to be held in London. Here is an opportunity to see how Joey creates her masterpieces in our own backyard.

JOEY RICHARDSON MASTER-CLASS Sunday 14th OR Monday 15th October: 8:30am -4:00pm

Joey has agreed to do a couple of one-day workshops on piercing, air brushing, carving and pyrography. These hands-on sessions will be held in my workshop in Clarence Town, with a maximum of just eight(8) participants per day. Sunday will be reserved for those who cannot attend on the Monday due to work or travel.

The fee for the Master-Class is **\$150** and will include lunch, tea, coffee and Joey's amazing talent, first-class instruction and sense of humour! Full details of requirements will be provided once you register, or you can contact me with any questions. I realise that some of you may not have all the specialist tools needed but there will be sufficient to share around on the day. Fees must be paid in full by Monday 2nd October.

When booking for the Master-Class please let me know if you are able to attend on the Monday, or just the Sunday. Remember that places are limited to just 8 per workshop and several people have already booked
