Phase 1 18 May – 31 May	Low risk activities permitted: Outside construction Internal and external Maintenance Timber Team Work to make the shed COVID safe SIG leaders can make a case to the Committee to re-start smaller SIGs of up to 10 people Max of 10 people allowed at the shed	 5 visitors at home, 10 in business and public places Restaurants, cafes and shops open for up to 10 people Local and regional travel Libraries, community centres and playgrounds open for up to 10 people ACT Government has agreed to 10 people at home, in business and in public places 	 Do not go to the shed if you are sick If you are diagnosed with COVID-19, contact the President immediately Keep 1.5 metres apart 4m2 per person Wash your hands with soap and water frequently Use hand sanitiser including when entering the shed Clean machinery controls and common use items like chucks and drills Don't share tools Bring your own cups, plates, utensils and milk Gloves and masks are optional
Phase 2 1 June	 Activities permitted: SIGs with up to 20 people in one room SIGs will restart (subject to the agreement of individual SIG leaders) Open on Tuesday, Thursday and Fridays Construction, maintenance, and timber team Ad hoc accreditation All the room limits apply concurrently. We can have a maximum of (25 + 20 + 16 + 13 + 6) 80 people at the shed.
